NOTE: Against the budget provision of Rs. 7000 crore in BE 2004-05, RE 2004-05 has been placed at Rs. 8506 crore for providing Additional Central Assistance to the States for execution of Externally Aided Projects. The expenditure on these projects (except structural adjustment programmes) is initially incurred by the States and thereafter reimbursement is claimed from Government of India. Releases from FY 2005-06 would be made on back to back basis as per accepted recommendations of the XII Finance Commission. Accordingly, grants amounting to Rs. 587.33 crore only have been provided for (Demand No. 36).
