on entertainment of dignitaries to Overseas Indian related events which may be held in India. It would also provide for expenditure on extending local hospitality to visiting delegations.

- 2.3 Other Expenditure: This includes expenditure on projects and schemes which the new Ministry may undertake during the course of the year and also for meeting expenditure on Pravasi Bhartiya Divas.
- 3. **Public Works**: The provision is primarily for acquisition/construction of the Pravasi Bhartiya Kendra.
