Defence Pensions provides for pensionary charges in respect of retired Defence personnel (including civilian employees) of the three Services viz. Army, Navy and Air Force and also employees of Ordnance Factories, etc. It covers payment of service pension, gratuity, family pension, disability pension, commuted value of pension, leave encashment and casualty awards such as War-Injury Pay and Gallantry awards like Param Vir Chakra, Mahavir Chakra, etc.

2. The increase in allocation in RE 2009-10 is mainly towards meeting additional expenditure on pensions on implementation of the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission. The provision in BE 2010-11 is for annual requirement towards 'Defence Pensions'.
