- Secretariat Economic Services: Provides for the Secretariat expenditure of the Union Minister and Minister of State for Planning.
 - 2. Planning Commission/Planning Board:
 - (a) Provides for the expenditure of Planning Commission including Programme Evaluation Organisation (PEO).
 - (b) Provides for "Modernisation of Office Systems", renovation and alteration of office premises, purchase of equipment and IT-related items.
 - (c) Provides for the establishment expenditure of the Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister.
 - (d) Provides for the expenditure of National Knowledge Commission set up to build excellence in Educational System to meet the knowledge challenges of the 21st century.

- 3. New Initiative in Skill Development through PPP: To build required skilled manpower to fulfill the needs of a growing and diversifying Indian Economy.
- Energy (R & D): Provides for support to R & D in the Power Sector for higher efficiency.
- UNDP Assistance: Provides for UNDP Assistance for Preparation of State Human Development Reports.
- 6. Plan Accounting and Public Finance Management System: To put in place a suitable MIS/DSS for tracking and reporting on the expenditures along with generation of Statewise/District-wise reports on the expenditure, outputs and the unutilized amount under each Plan Scheme.
- 7. Provides for Support to Planning Process at National, State and District Level.

- 8. Provides for UNDP Assistance for Rural Decentralisation and Participatory Planning for Poverty Reduction.
- 9. **Tsunami Rehabilitation Programme -** To provide assistance for project monitoring studies for environment assessment etc. including social assessment impact studies for Tsunami affected areas.

10. Others:

(a) For providing Grants-in-aid to Institute of Applied Manpower Research (IAMR) for strengthening its infrastructure and other activities.

- (b) Grants-in-aid to Universities and Research Institutions for training, research and institutional development, etc.
- (c) Payment for Professional and Special Services under the Scheme – "Expertise for Planning Process."
