5.51 Wheat and rice are issued by the Central Government at uniform Central Issue Prices (CIPs) to the States/UTs for distribution under TPDS.CIPs are higher for APL and much lower for BPL families. The periodical revisions in CIPs of rice and wheat under the PDS/TPDS are indicated in Table 5.14. Γ

5.52 Continued rise in MSP and the consequent economic cost, without commensurate increase in issue price has caused the food subsidy to rise. Further, reduction in PDS issue price for BPL and Antyodaya has further pushed up the size of food subsidy.
